

**Subject:** Important roadwork information: A47 Links Road Roundabout to Victoria Road Roundabout road markings



## **A47 Links Road Roundabout to Victoria Road Roundabout: road markings**

Dear Sir/Madam

We previously wrote to you in February about our intention to refresh the road markings on the A47 between Links Road Roundabout and Victoria Road Roundabout at Gorleston-on-Sea. Unfortunately, that work was postponed.

I am writing to you today to inform you that we now plan to complete this work over **two weeks** between **Monday 17 June and Friday 28 June**. We will work between **8pm to 6am** on weeknights only, weather conditions permitting.

Once complete, drivers will benefit from a safer, better-defined road surface.

Work will be carried out in phases, starting from Links Road Roundabout, moving northwards until work is complete at Victoria Road Roundabout.

Access to James Paget Hospital will remain open, either via Brasenose Avenue, Jenner Road or the main entrance via Kennedy Avenue. During the work, vehicles will be able to cross the A47 at Brasenose Avenue / Bridge Road.

Temporary signs will be in place to advise of any alternative arrangements.
