Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO8481) affecting the Beccles Road from 20m south of its junction with Herringfleet Road for 60m southwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Fritton with St. Olaves to facilitate bridge inspection works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 09:00 and 16:00 from 28<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2024, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 12<sup>th</sup> December 2024 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Beccles Road, Western Bypass, A12, Corton Long Lane, Millennium Way, Oulton Road, Peto Way, Fir Lane, Normanston Drive, Bridge Road, Saltwater Way, Marsh Road, Cotmer Road, A146 North Cove, A146 Worlingham, Norwich Road, Waterloo, Church Hill, The Street, Haddiscoe Dam (Lowestoft, North Cove, Corton, Beccles, Lound, Gillingham, Barnby, Blundeston, Mutford, Worlingham, Carlton Colville, Fritton and St. Olaves, Oulton, Haddiscoe, Oulton Broad, Bradwell, Belton with Browston, Hopton-on-Sea, Toft Monks).

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 12<sup>th</sup> December 2024 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
