

**Cllr. Daniel Candon reported the following to Bradwell Parish Council on 25<sup>th</sup> November 2024**

Firstly, Cllr. Candon conveyed his condolences on the passing of former Councillor John Shaw whom he said served his Parish well.

- Adizone work on play area has now started with ground being prepared for new play equipment to be installed.
- Issues around roadworks are outside Borough Councillors jurisdiction, however I for Bradwell North and Cllr. Annison for Bradwell South have been in touch with Norfolk County Council to enquire why work on both ends of Bradwell were done at the same time. We were informed that the decision was taken by the streetworks team of NCC. The works were completed as last Friday.

Cllr. Watson enquired about CCTV on the Mill Lane Community Park area. Cllr. Candon advised that a wide lensed CCTV will be looked into.

Cllr. Barron enquired how closely was his work with the Police. Cllr. Candon advised that he meets with PC Gray every six weeks when they discuss any ongoing issues and areas of concern. Cllr. Candon had obtained statistics and in the last three months five people had been prosecuted in Bradwell for crimes relating to anti-social behaviour. Criminal damage and violent and abusive behaviour we commonly call ASB, however, there is no authentic crime ASB. These statistics are taken from incidents reported to them in accordance with the provisions of the National Standards for Incidents recording. Again, people are urged to report through the official Police Incident Line 101.

Cllr. Spencer Vanderpal, although appreciated the roadworks are not in his jurisdiction, expressed concern that Bradwell was completely gridlocked with traffic and had emergency services been required they would not have been able to access a situation. Cllr. Candon advised that he had received numerous emails and phone calls, including Cllr. Wainwright as Chair of Governors at Hillside School, and he made recommendations on behalf of Bradwell residents of all concerns.

Cllr. Candon informed Councillors that he would support any application for a PCSO in Bradwell.
