St Nicholas Bradwell Church is a vibrant multi generational and welcoming community located at, **Church Walk, In Bradwell, NR31 8QQ.**

The church offers a variety of services to cater to different needs and preferences. The traditional 9am service provides a chance for the congregation to gather around the Lord's table and share the Eucharist. The main service at 10:30am is family-friendly, featuring a mix of modern and traditional songs, prayers, readings, and a talk. There is also a Sunday school that runs concurrently with the main service, where children engage in singing and crafts before rejoining the congregation.

St Nicholas Bradwell Church is dedicated to fostering a sense of community and belonging. They welcome people of all ages and backgrounds, whether they are exploring their faith or have a long-established relationship with God. The church emphasizes the importance of learning from the Bible and sharing the good news of Jesus Christ.
