I'm writing to tell you that we plan to carry out landscaping and maintenance work on the A47 Artillery Way between Gordon Road Roundabout and St Peters Street Roundabout. Once complete, drivers and residents will benefit from improved road safety and better environmental management.

We plan to complete this work over **one** night from **Saturday 29 March, 8pm to Sunday 30 March, 6am**, weather permitting.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your patience and apologise in advance for any noise and disturbance caused by our work.

Closures and diversions

To carry out the work safely, we will need to close the A47 Artillery Way, and divert traffic as detailed below:

A47 northbound diversion

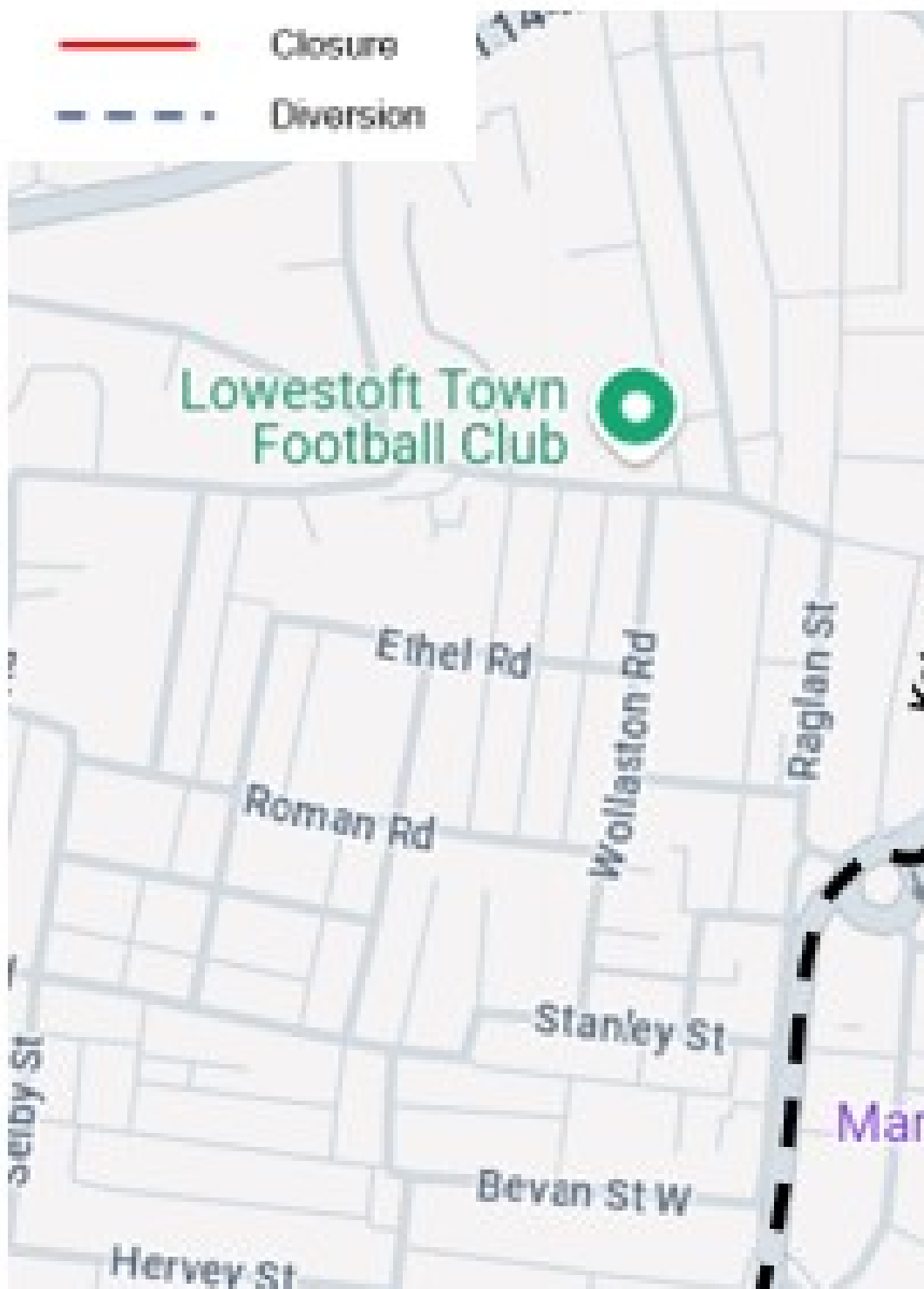
- Traffic intending to travel through the A47 Artillery Way northbound should turn around at Gordon Road Roundabout and proceed southbound along the A47.
- Continue to Horn Hill Roundabout and turnaround.
- Continue northbound on the A47 and exit onto Denmark Road.
- Turn right onto Katwijk Way.
- At the second roundabout, take the second exit onto St Peters Street.
- Road users can then rejoin the A47 to continue their journey northbound.

A47 southbound diversion

- Please follow the above diversion route in reverse.
